EXPLANATORY NOTE

1. The responsibility of a Railway Administration for loss, destruction, deterioration of the animals shall not exceed in the case of elephant Rs 6000 per head, horses Rs 3000 per head, mule, horned cattle or camel Rs 800 per head, dogs, donkeys, pigs, sheep or other animals or birds Rs 120 per head, unless a higher value is declared in clause 1 overleaf and an engagement entered into to pay the required percentage charge on excess value. The entire clause should be struck out by the sender or his agent if no declaration of higher value is made. Railway Administration will not be liable for damage or loss arising from fright of restiveness of any animals or birds overloading of wagons by the consignor or his agent irrespective of whether the sender has paid percentage charge on excess value or not.
2. unless the consignor declares in clause (2) & (3) overleaf the value of any consignment & pays percentage charge on excess value as required by Railways Extent of Monetary Liability and Prescription of Percentage Charge Rules 1990, the maximum limit of amount of monetary liability of Railway Adm for loss, destruction, damage, deterioration or non-delivery of the consignment shall not exceed (a) Rs 100 per kg in respect of consignment booked as personal baggage and (b) Rs 50 per kg in respect of consignment other than animal and personal baggage.
3. No Railway Adm shall accept for carriage the locos specified in Part-I of Schedule-II (Railways of Monetary Liability and Prescription of Percentage Charge Rules 1990), unless the consignor declares the value of such goods and pays percentage charge as applicable to such goods.
4. Wherever internal packing condition has been shown in the tariff against a commodity the fact whether the internal packing prescribed has been provided or not, should be recorded in Clause 4 overleaf. The consignment will not be accepted for carriage unless the declaration as per Clause 4 overleaf is recorded.
5. A consignment not packed in accordance with the Rly Rules, will not be accepted for carriage unless the nature of defects e.g. “not packed as per Rly Rules” “2 cases plank broken” 12 drums leaky etc etc are recorded against Clause 5 overleaf.
6. A consignment which is already in bad condition, will not be accepted for carriage unless exact condition e.g. “bales wet” “content smelling” etc is recorded in Clause 6 overleaf
7. Wherever compulsory packing condition has been shown in tariff against a commodity, the consignment will not be accepted for carriage unless the internal & other packing conditions prescribed have been complied with the declaration as per Clause 7 overleaf, is recorded.
8. When alternative Railway Risk and ‘Owner Risk’ rates are quoted, the letter will apply, unless the sender in Clause 8 overleaf enter the words “Railway Risk” when he will pay or engage to pay the higher and will reserve a certificate with this effect.
9. When a consignment is to be charged via the next cheapest extra route, the cheapest route being close or partially closed, the route by which the consignment is to be charged, must be recorded in Clause 10 overleaf.

Note:- All Clauses and words which are inapplicable are to be struck out before the Forwarding Note is signed
