## NOTICE

Subject: Winding up of National Meat and Poultry Processing Board –reg.

The National Meat and Poultry Processing Board (NBPPB) was established by Ministry of Food Processing Industries (MoFPI), Govt. of India vide Notification dated 20.01.2009 and was registered as a Society on 26.03.2009 under the Societies Registration Act 1860 (i.e. SRA 1860) vide Registration No.S/65215/2009 by the Registrar of Societies under Govt. of NCT of Delhi.

- It was established with the provision of funding of the Government for the first three years, i.e. upto 2012-13 and thereafter, it had to generate its own revenue. However, the Board was unable to generate its revenue and was not in a position to continue its activities without Government funding. Consequently, it was decided to wind up the NMPPB and accordingly orders were issued by MoFPI on 25.11.2014 directing NMPPB to take further action in the matter.
- 3. In pursuance thereto, the Managing Committee of NMPPB (i.e. the Board) vide Item No.2 of its 21<sup>st</sup> Meeting held on 26.11.2014 resolved to wind up NMPPB and take further action as required under the law. However, the immediate winding up of NMPPB could not be effected as one Public Interest Litigation (PIL) was filled in 2012 before High Court of Allahabad. Now, Hon'ble High Court disposed of the above case as infructuous.
- 4. In accordance with the decision of MoFPI as referred to in Para 2 above and resolution passed by the NMPPB as stated in Para 3 above, it is, therefore, informed now that the Board (i.e. NMPPB) shall stand wound up after 15 days of publication of this Notice in 4 leading Newspaper having national presence. The formal dissolution of the aforesaid Board shall be made thereafter in accordance with the provisions contained in the Memorandum of Association (MoA) and Rules and Regulations of NMPPB read with the relevant provisions contained the Societies Registration Act 1860.
